THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED WILL BE CELEBRATED ON A SUNDAY. (NOVEMBER 2ND)

The Feast of All Souls falls on a Sunday this year. This means that the Saturday 4:00 PM Mass and the Sunday schedule of Masses at 8:00, 9:45, and 11:30 AM will commemorate the Faithful Departed. At all the Masses on All Souls Day, we will remember those who have gone before us. We will also continue the parish custom by remembering those parishioners who have died since last November 2nd. Since All Souls Day falls on a weekend this year, all of us can take advantage of this by gathering families and close friends to be with us at St. Florian. This can truly offer much consolation, hope, and reassurance in Christ's promise of eternal life to those who have gone before us.

A Book of Remembrance will be present in the church where the names of our deceased can be written and prayed for. Please come forward and inscribe the names of your deceased.

We also ask that everyone uses the All Souls Day envelope found in your packet. Simply write the names of the deceased so Masses in memory of them can be celebrated not only throughout the month of November, but during the year as well.
