HEGEWISCH (pronounced "heg-wish") is one of 77 community areas of Chicago, Illinois located on the city's far south side. It is bordered by the neighborhoods of Riverdale & South Deering to the west, the East side to the north, the village of Burnham to the south and the city of Hammond, Indiana to the east. It is part of the 10th ward of Chicago. It has a commuter rail station on the South Shore Line. The community area is named for Adolph Hegewisch, the president of U.S. Rolling Stock Company who hoped to establish "an ideal workingman's community" when he laid out the town along a rail line in 1883, six years before Chicago annexed the town.
